BAIT-US-SALAM UPDATES

Baitussalam Welfare Trust: 6690 mun meat distributed amongst the needy this Eid ul Azha

5274 cows, 850 sheep and 300 goats were sacrificed in yet one of the biggest collective sacrificial program carried out BST this Eid ul Azha. The meat was distributed 63 locations covering Bangladesh, Syria and Pakistan. More than 13 lacs individuals received the sacrificial meat.

16 distribution center each were set up in Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Sindh, whereas 5 centers in Baluchistan and 7 centers in the Northern areas of Pakistan to facilitate the meat distribution.

In Bangladesh a border location was selected whereas in Syria, 2 facilitation centers were setup.

267,600 kgs of meat was distributed in total! Out of this, 799,000 individuals



received meat in Sindh (1598 cows), 223,000 in Punjab (446 cows), 35000 in Baluchistan (70 cows), 104500 in in KPK (209 cows), 100,500 in Northern Areas (201 cows), 51000 in Syria and 25000 refugees in Bangladesh.

50 cows were sacrificed in Baluchistan and 125 mun meat was distributed amongst the Rohingya refugees living in camps in



the border areas.

850 sheep were sacrificed in Syria for the Syrian refugees and 850 families translating to approximately 51000 individuals received meat.

It was a huge task undertaken but Allhamdulillah was well managed and organized with the BST volunteers' team working round the clock.

Recurrence of blasphemous cartoons is a failure of Muslim world: PM

Prime Minister Imran Khan said that the recurrence of sacrilegious cartoon competitions is the collective failure of Muslims worldwide.



He made these comments on the floor of the Senate after the House unanimously passed a resolution condemning the sacrilegious cartoon competition being held in the Netherlands.

Imran Khan said that his government would raise this issue at the United

Nations. "However, I believe that it won't be very effective as the West does not understand our love for the Prophet (SAW)," he said.

They would not back off from holding the competition as they

consider it a matter of freedom of speech, the premier said.

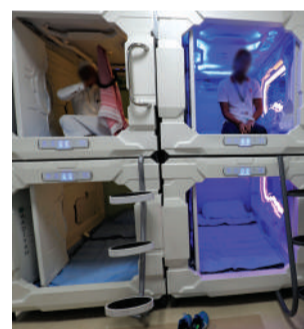
"They don't understand our love for the Prophet (SAW)," the PM said, adding that they [Westerners] don't understand how much this blasphemous material hurts sentiment.

Imran Khan said that the Organization of Islamic Countries (OIC) will have to take a lead on this issue. "The OIC should have formulated a strategy a long ago to tackle this issue," he said.

The sleep stations – based on Japan's famous capsule hotels – will offer clean sheets and air-conditioning



Saudi Arabia plans to introduce sleep pods, reminiscent of Japan's famed capsule hotels, in the western city of Mina in the coming days, as an estimated two million Muslims gather for the six-day hajj, one of the five pillars of Islam.

The free pods are part of new measures being rolled out this year in a bid to modernise the centuries-old practice of hajj.

The government has also introduced apps for on-the-spot translation and emergency medical care.

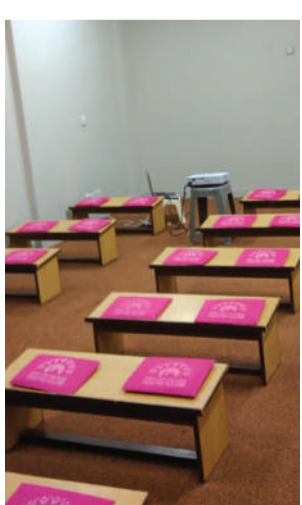

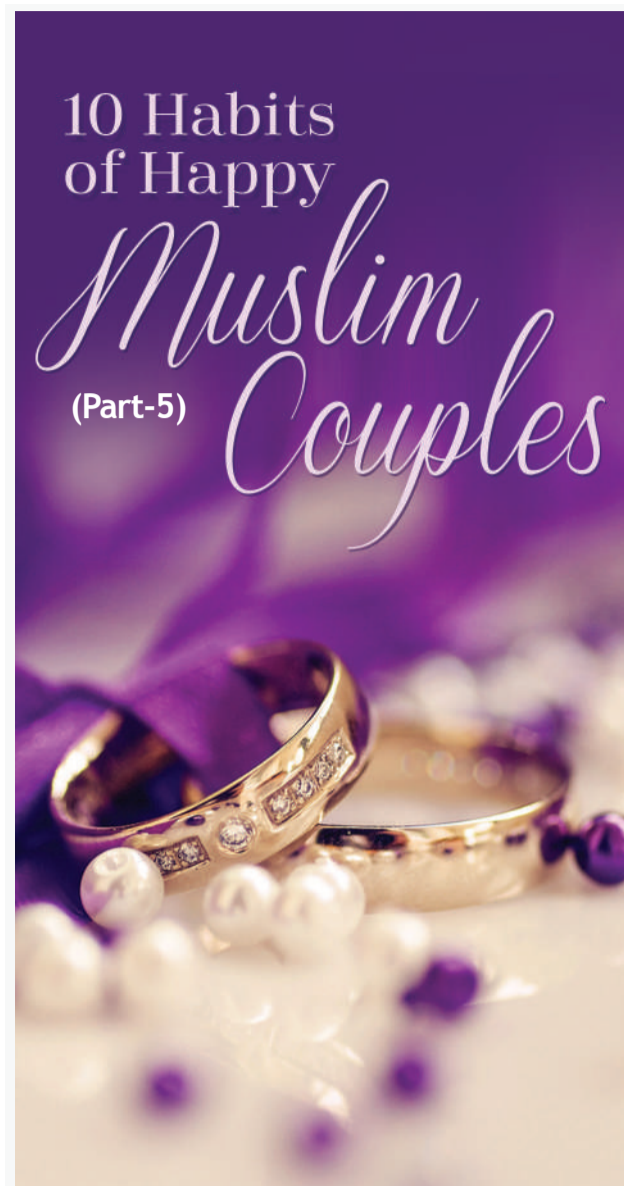

10 Habits of Happy Muslim Couples
 (Part-5)

"This is who I am and you better get used to it"
 "I wouldn't have said/done that if you didn't say/do what you did"
 "It's all because of you"
 "Does it look like I care anyway?"
 And ego sounds very, very familiar.
 This is because the lower self is a covert enemy lurking within each and every one of us.
 Why ego is the biggest threat to a marriage is because it is an enemy from within. Ego is like a deceptive double agent that distorts reality and makes us deny and justify the wrongs that our lower selves commit towards our spouses, convincing us that we are right; while we are oppressing our own selves and our spouses and actually walking a path of humiliating self-destruction.
 There's no one who mirrors our souls to us more accurately than our spouse, because no other human being gets to see us as intimately and habitually as they do. As a natural consequence, spouses stand the highest chance of facing our ego: the defensive wrath of our lower selves. But allowing your lower self to prevail in your marriage instead of seeing your marriage as a means to purify yourself is your own (disastrous)

choice.
 Our spouses actually personify the mercy of Allah (SWT) when they mirror our flaws to us so we can rise above our lower selves. They make us discern our innermost weaknesses that we could not have seen for ourselves, and Allah (SWT) has blessed us with them for our own spiritual purification and salvation.
 The next time your spouse is desperately trying to get something about yourself across to you:
 1. Just listen. Listen carefully and objectively, especially if they have been repeating it for a very long time.
 2. Control the urge to defend yourself: look for the truth in your spouse's words first.
 3. Ask yourself: "Has anyone pointed this out about me before?" The answer could very likely be a yes, and if it is, then you're definitely looking at a flaw that Allah (SWT) wants you to work on and get rid of.
 4. Realize how merciful Allah (SWT) is being to you through your spouse. Thank Allah (SWT) and your spouse sincerely for caring so much about your success in the hereafter and making you a better person.
 Evil Eye
 The Prophet (SAW) said:

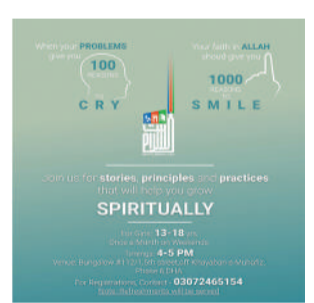
"The evil eye is real." [Ibn Majah]
 I am always in awe of the power of this extremely concise hadith, because it delivers three vital messages about the evil eye in one 5-word sentence:
 •the harm of the evil eye is very, very real (in case you were even thinking otherwise)
 •do not put yourself in its way; and
 •take measures to protect yourself from it
 If you agree with point one, the second and third points just follow naturally. Muslim couples today are actually serving their marriages on exquisitely decorated social media platters for the evil eye to devour: not just the ceremony, but every single verbal and non-verbal marital exchange, meal, meeting, moment, mood and micro-second!
 Happy Muslim couples do share their marital happiness, but sensibly. Before sharing anything about your marital life with the public, ask yourself:
 •Is it necessary to share it with all the people I'm about to disclose it to?
 •Will it make any of them long to be in my position?
 •Is it better off being private?

Haji 'nap pods' being introduced for pilgrims to Saudi Arabia
 the Haji and Mutamer Gift Charitable Association, is offering between 18 and 24 capsules for pilgrims to nap in for free in the coming days.
 Each fibreglass pod - less than three metres long and just over one metre high - features a mattress, clean sheets, air conditioning and a large, well-lit mirror.
 The pods can be lined up horizontally or stacked vertically to save on space.
 Each napper will have three hours so sleep in the pods, which are imported from Japan at cost of around \$1,114 each.
 When the pilgrim wakes for prayer time - five times daily in Islam - workers will sterilise the pod before handing it over to the next pilgrim.
 "We believe it's extremely well-suited for crowded places in our holy sites and in Mecca," Amer said.
 But for hajj, which takes pilgrims across Mecca and Mina - cities in western Saudi Arabia home to the holiest sites of Islam - the pods were also inspired by the rising popularity of car and bike-sharing.
 "The capsules work through a share economy, like bicycles that you can rent for an hour and then leave for someone else," said a representative.
 A trial run of 12 pods earlier this year was, he said, a success. He estimates 60 people used each pod every day during the fasting month of Ramadan.

Facts, Events & Beliefs
 Ostrich eyes are the largest of any animal that lives on land (though they can't rival some of the massive creatures that inhabit the depths of the sea). Approximately the size of a billiard ball, their eyes are actually bigger than their brains.
 3. Cardinals like to cover themselves in ants.
 Cardinals (along with several other bird species) sometimes cover themselves in crushed or living ants, smearing them over their feathers, or allowing living ants to crawl on them. While scientists still aren't sure what the purpose of "anting" is, some believe the birds use the formic acid secreted during their ant bath to help get rid of lice and other parasites.
 4. Owls devour their prey whole.
 When owls catch larger animals (raccoons and rabbits, for instance), they tear them up into more manageable, bite-size pieces. But, they've also been known to simply swallow smaller animals, from insects to mice, whole.
 5. Some ducks sleep with one eye open.
 When they nap in groups, the ducks on the perimeter keep guard by sleeping with one eye open. While the other ducks sleep more deeply, those on the outside of the circle also keep one side of their brain awake, even as they doze.
 6. Kiwis are sometimes called "honorary mammals."
 Native to New Zealand, kiwis are a bizarre, land-bound bird. Scientists, so mystified by the kiwi's strange properties—which include feathers that feel like hair, heavy bones filled with marrow, and nostrils on the tip of their nose (rather than on the base of their beak like most birds)—have sometimes called them "honorary mammals."
 7. Parrots can learn to say hundreds of words.
 While most parrots only learn around 50 words, some African grey parrots have been known to learn hundreds.
 8. Woodpeckers hoard acorns.
 Acorn woodpeckers store acorns by drilling holes in trees, fence posts, utility poles, and buildings, and depositing their nuts there. They have been known to store up to 50,000 acorns—each in its own tiny hole—in a single tree, called a "granary tree."
 9. The unique black and white coloring of penguins works as camouflage.
 While penguins might stand out on land, underwater their black and white coloring helps them stay hidden from both predators and prey. As they swim, their black backs blend in with the darker ocean water below them so that they're difficult to spot from above. Their white chests, meanwhile, help them blend in with the lighter, brighter surface of the water, so that from below, they're near-invisible.
 10. Budgies catch each other's yawns.
 Budgerigars, or budgies, a common parakeet, are the only bird species so far discovered who is susceptible to contagious yawning. Budgies are the first non-mammal species observed exhibiting the behavior. Many scientists believe the unconscious, instinctual response may be a primitive way of showing empathy, or it might be a sign of group alertness.
